Andrew Logan, British sculptor, artist and jewelry maker, was at Siddhartha Art Gallery in Baber Mahal on Saturday for a talk and power point presentation about his work.

Logan mainly uses glasses and mirrors, on which he paints portraits of his friends or famous icons. On a query from the audience, he replied that he was obsessed by the mirrors and glasses because 'it sparkled'.

"My art is mainly about transformation, as I collect things - abandoned and forgotten - from the places

I visit and transform it into art. For one of my work, I took left out pieces from my

garden to make into a beautiful sculpture, 'rescued and recreated,' he shared.

He uses symbols accumulated from different cultures from around the world and pieces them together. Although his sculptures are up to 8 foot in size sometimes, Logan said at the talk program that he never makes a drawing.

Logan's works have been exhibited in many countries including Russia, China and Singapore, and in many places in London.

Founder of the Alternative Miss World, which is a platform to translate extraordinariness and creativity into costumes, without any rehearsal - he concurred that he likes to show his art rather than talk about it.
